Acceptable Behaviour Code for all Junior Members

Without an element of discipline, particularly at junior level, the game of Squash could result in serious injury. To help maintain this, as a member of the Wrexham Brymbo Squash Club, all juniors will be expected to wear safety goggles on court and follow certain rules when attending the Club, either on or off court during sessions or when representing the Squash Club in matches at other venues. Your coaches and accompanying adult supporters should not have to tolerate any of the following indiscipline, which could lead to an accident: -

- General misbehaviour
- Racket abuse
- Lack of effort
- Disrespect
- Bullying (Verbal or Physical), or
- Foul Language

Any member of Wrexham Brymbo Squash Club contravening this behaviour code will, at the discretion of the coach in charge, be warned and incur the following penalty against him / her: –

- ❑ **First offence** – will be asked to leave court and take no further part in the session and, following discussion with their parent / guardian, may be suspended from the following weeks coaching session or match;
- ❑ **Second offence** – will be asked to leave court and be suspended from the next two coaching sessions or matches;
- ❑ **Third offence** – the junior member will not be allowed to take part in any future coaching programme run through Wrexham Brymbo Squash Club. Persistent offenders may also have their Club membership terminated.

At each and every stage, the parents of any junior member who contravenes the Acceptable Behaviour Code will be notified, with a request to meet with our coaches to discuss the problem.
