Sport Freelance Fund

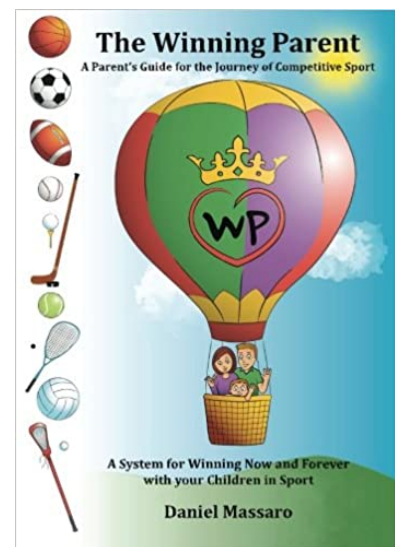
